## Rules & Guidelines for Participants

**Inclement Weather Date: Sunday, December 12, 2021 at 2:30 PM**

**Entry Requirements:** There is no entry fee; however, we do collect canned foods/nonperishable items for **Second Harvest Food Bank of Northwest North Carolina**. Collection boxes will be set up at parade line-up locations and at Town Hall and the Rural Hall Fire Department. Please encourage your participants to bring items for the food drive!

**\*\*Route\*\*:** The parade has changed this year due to staging needs. The parade route will proceed south down Broad Street. It will begin at the intersection of Washington Street and end at Wall Street.

**Line-up Information:** Line-up times and locations are assigned based on the information you provide. Please provide accurate, detailed information. You will be contacted with line-up information, most likely the week before the parade. Please line up at your assigned time and location.

**Line-up Communication & Parking:** Please adequately communicate line-up TIME and LOCATION with your parade participants and avoid last-minute drop-offs.

**Vehicle/Trailer Safety:** Children are NOT allowed to ride on trailers or floats without adult supervision. Only trailers with railings are allowed. Absolutely NO riding on the front of vehicles. *Town officers reserve the right to stop any unsafe vehicle activity.*

**Animals:** All animals must be on a restraint and controlled by an adult. No aggressive animals permitted. Horse entries will be assigned to a designated grass location to line up and participants are required to clean up after their horses/animals during the parade.

**Candy:** You may toss candy during the parade, but please toss carefully and avoid throwing at spectators.

**Santa:** Please do not have Santa on your float. We will have Santa at the end of the parade.

**Trash:** There will be trash receptacles at line-up locations. Please make sure to clean up after yourself/your group and dispose of all trash.

**Restrooms:** There will be port-a-johns / restroom facilities available at line-up locations.
